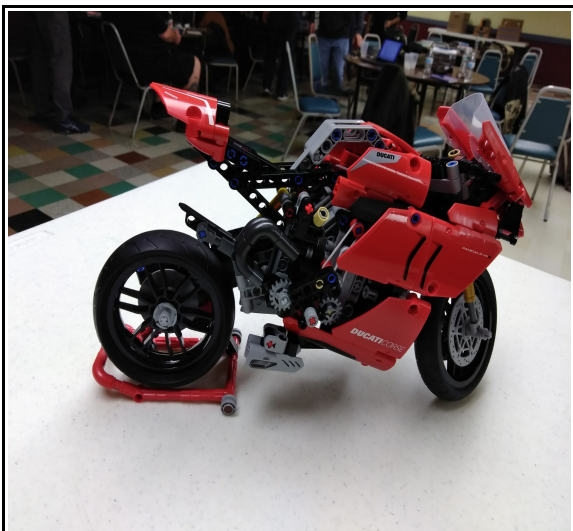


Matt McCray brought in a
