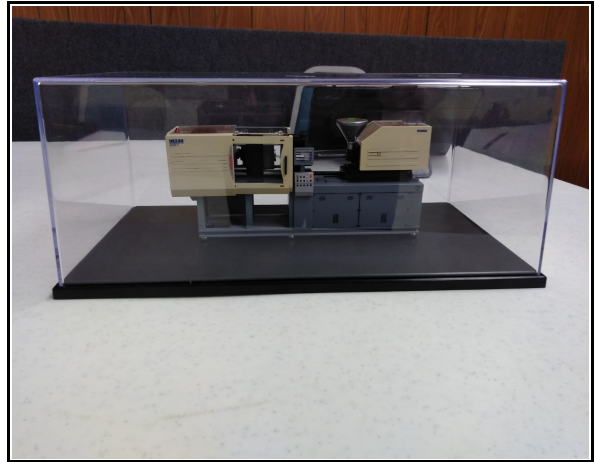
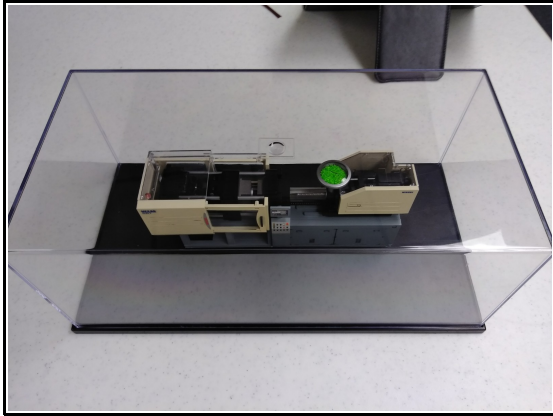
This years membership dues are still owed if you have not yet paid.
