We are gradually gaining new members.

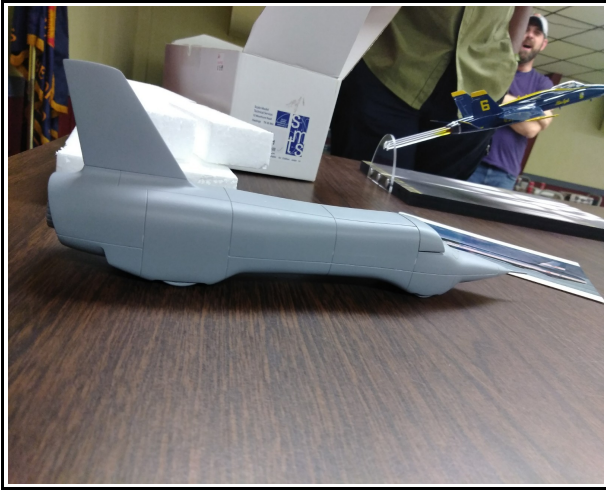
Suggestions for invigorating the meetings are always welcome.

Charlie also talked about his resin car kit of the Spirit Of America Land Speed Record holder from the late 1960's work in progress.

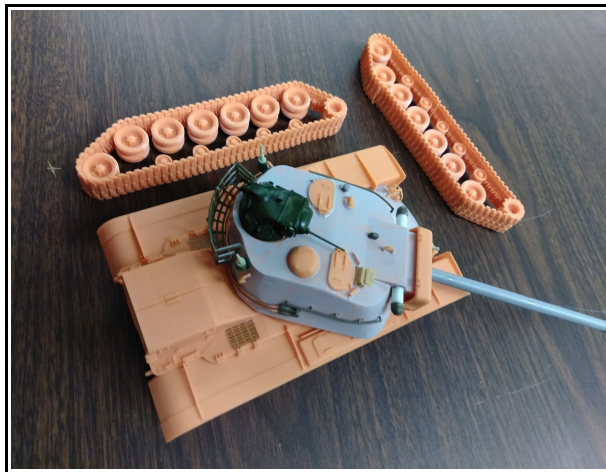

3D printed T110e4 Heavy Tank World of Tanks Game. The kit came from Resinscales from China in 1/35 scale it required cleanup and the photo showed the bustle rack, searchlight mount and grenade launchers which are listed as accessories and not available.





Mark Spalding brought in a 1/24 scale Airfix F6 Hellcat. It is based on a photo of the plane his father flew on the USS Randolph in WW2. The cockpit and engine bay is plumbed and wired. The kit has extensive aftermarket parts. It is painted with dark sea blue Tamiya paint. The life raft was scratchbuilt.
